An atmosphere of acceptance and caring pervades this Christian camp program. Counselors and their campers plan, work, play, worship, and grow together as they strive to build a Christ-centered community of trust, openness, sharing, and forgiveness. Campers are challenged to know Jesus Christ more deeply as they grow spiritually, physically, emotionally, and socially. - do my share of my group's work responsibilities.
- listen respectfully to what other campers and my counselors have to say.
- let my counselors know if I have a problem, concern, or feel homesick.
- respect other people's things and use them only if they give me permission.
- stay with my group at all times unless I have permission to leave.
- bring only those items to camp which are allowed.
- take responsibility for my actions and accept the consequences of my behavior (which could include temporary removal from the group or an activity; a call home to inform parents/guardians of my behavior; or dismissal from camp).
- cooperate with my counselors and other adult leaders.
- find peaceful ways to solve any problems or disagreements.... physical and/or verbal aggressiveness will not be tolerated.
- seek the good and the positive in everything I do.

Together, please carefully read and talk about, and sign this agreement before coming to camp. Please mail this, along with other supplemental materials, to camp before your first day of camp.
